Over an area of seventeen hectares, animals from all continents make their home in the Vienna Zoo. In an ambience which is partly baroque, visitors can encounter giant pandas, koalas, rhinoceros, elephants, seals, orang-utans, giraffes and more.

In total, more than 600 species of animal find a home in the Schönbrunn Zoo, including some of the world's most seriously endangered species.




