A gastronomic journey through the zoo: the zoo has wide range of culinary delights to satisfy every taste to refresh you on your day at the zoo! There are also numerous  kiosks to pick up a quick snack or drink.



KAISERPAVILLON

The Kaiserpavillon, located in the centre of the zoo, serves traditional Viennese cuisine and international specialties. Its terrace looks out on to the giant pandas and the African animal enclosures.

HOUSE RULES (ABRIDGED)

- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. Adults are responsible for the children in their care.
- For safety reasons, some areas of the zoo are under video surveillance.
- A strict feeding ban is in place throughout the zoo. The only exception is the petting zoo, where only food provided by the zoo may be used.
- Petting animals is permitted only in the petting zoo and at visitors' own risk.
- Climbing over barriers and reaching into enclosures is strictly prohibited. Placing children on enclosure barriers and pre-enclosure barriers is not permitted.
- Tapping on glass, making loud noises, and playing loud music and musical instruments is prohibited.
- Visitors must keep off the grass at all times. Causing damage to plants is prohibited.
- Bringing dogs or any other animals into the zoo is prohibited. Assistance dogs are permitted, provided they have a harness vest and an up-to-date immunisation record. The dog's ID and immunisation record must be shown at the ticket office.
- The use of bicycles, balance bikes, rollerblades, scooters, skateboards, drones, or similar items is prohibited.
- Use of the playgrounds is at visitors' own risk.
- Ball games, frisbees, etc. are not allowed, and visitors are not permitted to bring balloons with them into the zoo.
- Please help keep the zoo tidy by using the waste bins provided.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in all indoor areas and at the children's playgrounds.
- Visitors are welcome to make video clips and take photographs (without flash) for private purposes. Commercial shoots, however, require a permit.
- Please keep your admission ticket safe and be prepared to show it to a member of staff if asked to do so. Tickets are no longer valid once you leave the zoo.
- No refunds will be given if individual animal houses, enclosures or areas are closed.
- Please leave the zoo promptly at the end of visiting hours. The exit turnstiles are locked 30 minutes after the zoo closes.
- Weapons are strictly prohibited throughout the Schönbrunn Zoo premises.
- Zoo employees' instructions must be followed at all times.
- If you fail to comply with these visitor rules, our staff may ask you to leave the premises. In such cases, no refunds will be issued. For serious violations, we reserve the right to involve the police.
